Course Title: Magnetic Resonance Imaging Didactic Education for Registered Technologists

CATALOG DESCRIPTION: This course is designed for Registered Radiologic Technologists requiring structured education in Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI). Topics include patient care, safety, image production, and procedures. This course satisfies the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) post-primary requirements of structured education in MRI. Restricted to students who are Certified and Registered by the ARRT in Radiography, Nuclear Medicine, Radiation Therapy, or Sonography or the Nuclear Medicine Technology Certification Board (NMTCB) as a Certified Nuclear Medicine Technologist or the American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonography (ARDMS) as a Sonographer. Registration with approval from Radiography Program Director or Clinical Coordinator. Offered online only.

Registration Instructions:

2A. If you never attended NCC and do not intend to obtain a degree or certificate from NCC, you are a Guest/Visiting Student.
